### Missions for April

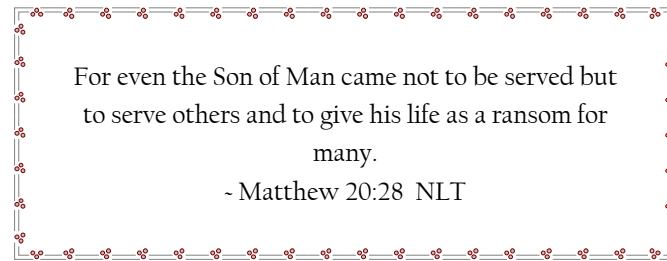

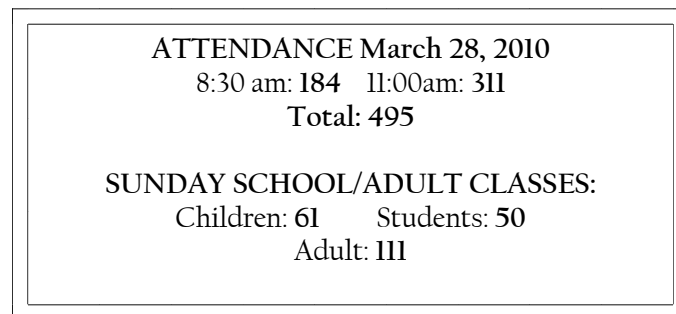
