## LIGHT House

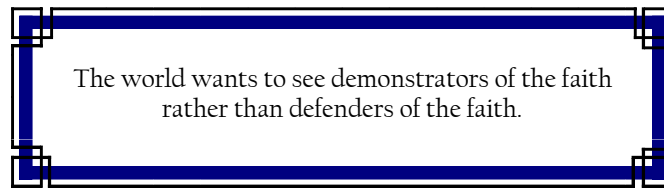
