Worship Team Video Techs wanted

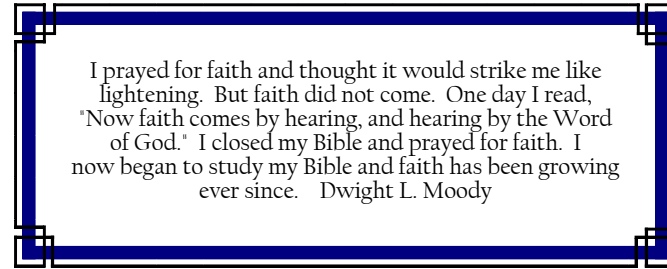
