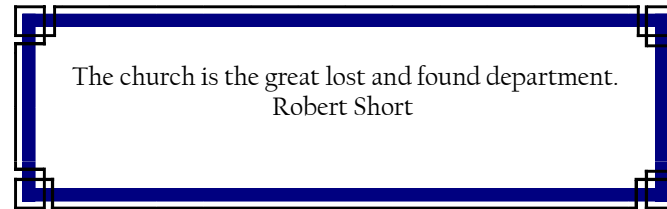
Summer Women's Bible Study
