Middle School Mission Trip Postponed

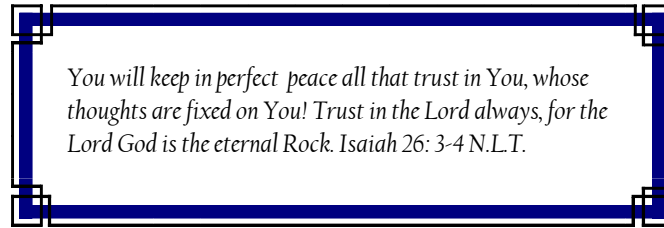
