Lil'K

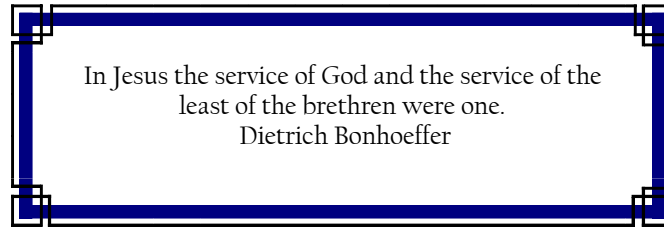

Winning the War Within**

Key concept: If we're going to experience the fullness of life in Christ, we need to live under the Holy Spirit's direction.

A. The war between the Spirit and the flesh: described and won. (16-18)

B. A self-test: is the flesh winning in you? (19-21)

C. Fullness of life comes from walking with/being led by the Spirit. (22-24)

D. The choice to make: walking alongside in agreement with the Spirit. (25-26)

Application: how can I walk with, be led by, the Spirit?
