Painting

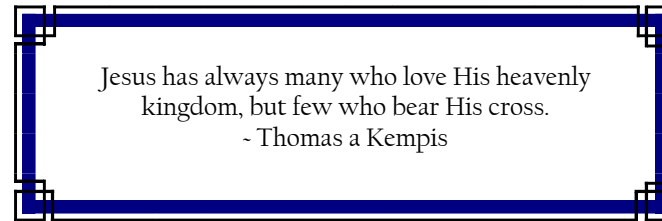
