Women's Bible Study

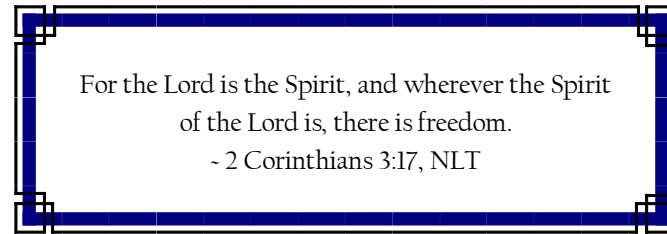
Ladies it's not too late to join the Women's Bible study by Kay Arthur "Lord Is It Warfare?". We will be doing it all summer so feel free to jump in!
