

Litigation Update

In early May Heartland Presbytery filed an amended petition in Clay County Circuit Court in an effort to overcome the deficiencies in their original complaint which led to its dismissal. Subsequently we renewed our Motion to Dismiss on several legal grounds. Presbytery responded to that Motion with arguments that we believe are still deficient. We have now filed a Reply Brief in further support of our Motion to Dismiss. Unless something unexpected occurs we do not anticipate requesting another oral hearing. The Court could order another hearing on its own or Presbytery could request a hearing but we think a second hearing is unlikely. The Court could rule on the Motion to dismiss at any time but it is likely it will be Fall (or even later) before we know anything further. "Help! My friend doesn't believe in God, what should I say?"

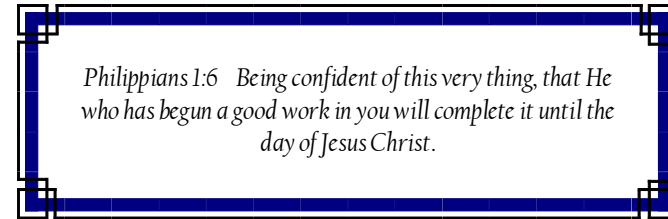
